KANSAS CITY, Mo. – Nebraska Wesleyan University senior Greg Timblin (Greenwood, Neb.) has been named the Association of Division III Independents men's cross country Runner of the Week. Timblin placed 29th overall at the Woody Greeno/Nebraska Invitational held on Sept. 16 at Pioneers Park in Lincoln, Neb. His time of 27:14.65 was first on NWU's team, which placed second in the College Division and fourth overall, ahead of several NCAA Div. II teams, including No. 24 ranked Central Missouri State University. The Prairie Wolves are ranked sixth in the Div. III preseason poll and are coached by Dr. Ted Bulling.

Her time was 23:21.25, and she helped the NWU women place second in the College Division and fourth overall as a team. The Prairie Wolves finished ahead of several NCAA Div. I and II programs, including Colorado School of Mines, which was ranked No. 17 in the preseason poll for Division II. The NWU women are ranked No. 10 in Division III under head coach Dr. Ted Bulling.
