

# THEATRE SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

## Audition and Interview Requirements

All students auditioning for Nebraska Wesleyan Fine Arts scholarships must apply for admission and be accepted prior to the audition dates. Students applying for scholarships need to be in the top one-half of their class or have an ACT score of 21 or higher.

**For regular decision, the deadline for theatre scholarship applications is April 15, 2009. For Early Action 2008-2009, the audition application date is November 15, 2008.**

*Students applying for Early Action* should contact the Theatre Arts office at (402) 465-2378 to arrange an audition and interview.

## On-Campus Audition and Interview Information

Schedule an on-campus theatre scholarship audition and interview at your earliest convenience; audition and interview appointments may be made by contacting the Student Recruitment Assistant on Monday through Friday from 3 to 5 at your convenience at **(402) 465-2378 or 1-800-541-3818**. Plan to spend part of the afternoon (1-2 hours) on the campus for your interview, during which you will meet with the theatre faculty, and present an audition piece or evidence of technical theatre experience.

If possible, the Nebraska Wesleyan University Theatre faculty encourages you to schedule your audition and interview so you would be able to ***attend one of Nebraska Wesleyan University's theatre performances*** on the evening of your audition and interview. The Nebraska Wesleyan University Box Office will make arrangements for ***complimentary tickets*** for you and your family.

If you are interested in a ***performance*** scholarship please be prepared to demonstrate one of the following:

- 1.) Two contrasting contemporary monologues of no more than 2 minutes each.
- 2.) One contemporary monologue and at least 16 bars of a musical theatre song.

If you are interested in any phase of ***technical theatre***, please bring a portfolio of your work (such as photos of scenery or costumes, drawings, directing scripts, or other appropriate materials).
