Student Teaching Options

Traditional Student Teaching - Student teach in Lincoln or surrounding communities.

Overseas Student Teaching - A half semester of student teaching in England, Ireland, Scotland, Wales, New Zealand, India, Germany, Taiwan, or Australia may be combined with a half semester student teaching in a Nebraska school.

#Students who will be endorsed in two areas should register for two 7-hour student teaching experiences, Ed. 287.

#Students in Music register for Ed. 278 - Supervised Teaching Elementary Music - 7 hours and Ed. 283 - Supervised Teaching Secondary Music - 7 hours.

#Students in other K-12 programs will register for Ed. 280 - Supervised Teaching in Elementary School or Ed. 281 for K-12 PE majors - 7 hours and Ed. 287 - Supervised Teaching in Secondary Schools -7 hours.

***You must be accepted as a candidate in the TEACHER EDUCATION PROGRAM in order to take these courses.**

NOTE: The above requirements are for students working toward a B.S. or B.A. degree. B.M. degree students follow a different requirement listing of Education courses. See Music Requirements.

Other Requirements:

Earn 12 hours in Education in Residence in addition to student teaching. Last 30 hours in Residence.
