National liberal arts colleges are defined as institutions that "emphasize undergraduate education" and "award at least 40% of their degrees in liberal arts disciplines." Wesleyan is also included in *Barron's Best Buys in College Education*—a guidebook used by high school students selecting colleges. *Barron's Best Buys* ranks Wesleyan as one of the top 300 college values in the nation.

Technology

Nebraska Wesleyan has been ranked as one of the "100 most wired" schools in the nation, according to *Yahoo: Internet Life*. Every Wesleyan student has a computer account that provides unlimited access to the campus network and the Internet, and all residence halls are wired with Ethernet accessibility. Wesleyan has over 600 computers and a student-to-computer ratio of 6 to 1. We also have a trained Student Technology Assistance Resource Team (START) available to assist members of the campus community.

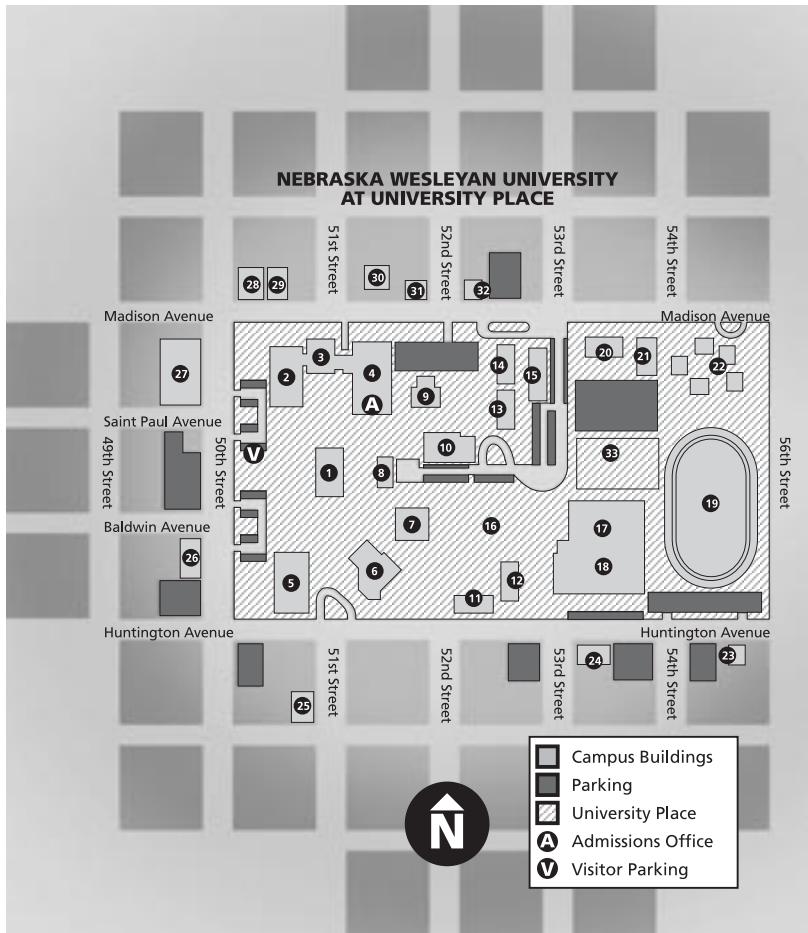
