### The Game (Season Opener)

The Nebraska Wesleyan University football team will open the 2010 season this Saturday (Sept. 4) when they travel to Seward, Neb., to take on Concordia University.

Kickoff between the Prairie Wolves and the Bulldogs is set for 1 p.m., at Bulldog Stadium in Seward, Neb.

The game can be heard live locally on KFOR 1240 AM or online at kfor1240.com with veteran broadcaster Dick Janda calling the action.

NWU is looking to rebound from its disappointing 5-5 season in 2009. The Prairie Wolves return eight starters from the 2009 team, including five on defense, two on offense and the starting punter. Nebraska Wesleyan was picked to finish seventh in the preseason GPAC Coaches poll.

Concordia opened their 2010 season last Saturday (Aug. 28) with a 13-7 victory at Peru State College in a non conference game. The Bulldogs will look to carry that momentum from their opening week victory into the GPAC opener this Saturday.

The Bulldogs returned 10 starters on offense and nine on defense from the 2009 team that finished 3-7 overall.

### The Coaches

Nebraska Wesleyan's **Brian Keller** begins his 15th season at the helm of his alma mater (NWU '83). The all-time winningest coach in NWU football history, Keller has compiled a 79-62 (.560) record in 14 seasons. He is now the dean of GPAC coaches as the longest tenured head coach.

He ranks 16th among active NAIA football coaches in victories with his 79 career wins.

**Vance Winter** is in his second season as the head football coach at Concordia University. He is now 4-7 overall as a head coach for the Bulldogs. He served as the defensive coordinator for Concordia for two seasons prior to taking over as head coach. Winter also had coaching stops at Peru State, Wayne State and Dakota State.

#### The NWU-Concordia Series

This will be the 49th meeting between Nebraska Wesleyan and Concordia in football in a series that began in 1958.

The Prairie Wolves hold a 31-17 lead in the all-time series and have now won the past two meetings between the two teams.

NWU is 13-12 in games played in Seward, Neb., with Concordia winning four of the last six meetings on their home field.

Since the GPAC started in 2000, NWU has a 6-4 advantage in the series over Concordia.

#### NWU in Season Openers

Nebraska Wesleyan is 51-46-5 (.523) all-time in season opening games.

The Prairie Wolves are 7-7 in season opening games under Coach Keller and have lost their last three season openers.

Saturday will be the first time that Nebraska Wesleyan will be playing Concordia in a season opening game.

The last time that NWU won a season opening game on the road was in the 2005 season as the Prairie Wolves won 24-10 at Briar Cliff.

#### NWU in the GPAC

Since the Great Plains Athletic Conference was formed during 2000, Nebraska Wesleyan has a 56-38 record in the GPAC. The Prairie Wolves have the fourth most wins since the GPAC started and the fifth best winning percentage. *(see complete list on page 5)*

#### Hauptman to Take Over as Signal Caller

One of the most competitive position battles during Fall camp was for the starting quarterback position. Four different players were in the running to take over for two-year starter Matt Hagge.

Coming out on top to earn the start in game one is sophomore **Nate Hauptman**. Hauptman (Omaha, Neb.) played on the junior varsity team last season and is yet to complete a pass in a varsity game.

Hauptman had a decorated prep career at Millard West H.S. He led the Wildcats to the 2008 Class A State Championship and was named Second-Team All-State. As a senior he set a school record with 1,569 passing yards completing 61% of his passes with 16 touchdowns.

#### Its About Fricke Time

After serving as a backup running back to Kory Kahlandt in high school at Lincoln Pius X and the past couple years in college, senior **Steve Fricke** finally gets his chance to take over as the feature back.

Fricke (Lincoln, Neb.) is the leading returning rusher for the Prairie Wolves after gaining 280 yards with a touchdown last season. He played the majority of the last two games to end 2009 filling in for injured Kahlandt and went on to produce 195 yards in the two games.

#### Fall Camp Notes, Injuries Give Young Players Chance

NWU has endured its share of injuries during fall camp, with several key players sidelined for this week's action. Senior captain **Garek Bebee** has started all 30 games of his career at offensive tackle, but will miss his first game of his career due to a knee injury. All-American return specialist **Jordan Delbaugh** has also missed time due to a hamstring injury.

Those two specific injuries have allowed young players to make their way into the lineup. The offensive line has shuffled spots moving true freshman **Ryan Beebe** into the starting lineup. On special teams, freshman **Aaron Lorraine** will be the top return man for kickoffs and punts.

**Defense Looks to Continue Dominance**

The Nebraska Wesleyan defense has become one of the top units in the country the past three seasons under defensive coordinator John Bates. In each of the last three years, NWU has finished the season ranked in the top 10 in the nation in total defense.

The Prairie Wolves added another shutout last season to bring their total to eight shutouts in 50 games under Coach Bates.

**Hunke Among Nations Best at Punter**

One of the most dangerous weapons on the NWU football team this season may be returning punter Ethan Hunke. Hunke (West Point, Neb.) was an honorable mention All-American last season after finishing third in the country averaging 41.7 yards per punt.

Hunke can be a game changer by pinning opponents deep in their own territory. He had 11 punts inside the 20 last year. Hunke currently has a 40.5 yard per punt average for his career, which is second on the NWU All-Time charts.

**Its a Family Affair**

The 2010 Nebraska Wesleyan football roster includes three sets of brothers, with one set of twins. Andrew and Ben Fedoris are twin brothers while Caleb and Josh Schmucker are another set of brothers. Joe and Ben Manley are the third set of brothers and the Manley brothers are listed 1-2 on the depth chart at split end.

In addition to the three sets of brothers, there are three other players who had older brothers play NWU football. Caleb Armstrong, Tanner Smith and Nate Strehle are all following the footsteps of their older siblings who put on the NWU football uniform. Also Sheldon Bouwens, a freshman line-backer, is the son of NWU great and former NFL player Shawn Bouwens.

**About the Bulldogs**

Concordia used a run oriented offense and a strong defensive effort to earn the 13-7 victory over Peru State in their season opener.

The Bulldogs managed just 199 yards of total offense, but held the Bobcats to only 228 yards while forcing two turnovers.

Quarterback **TJ Shirey** was the main offensive weapon for Concordia in the opener. Shirey carried the ball 27 times for 56 yards with a touch-down and also completed 12-22 passes for 63 yards with an interception.

Shirey played in all 10 games last season with a passing TD and two rushing TDs. Against NWU in 2009 he had 11 carries for (-1) yards and was 5-11 passing for 94 yards.

**Jake Griedl** and **Jamarcus Walker** are two other Bulldogs who will have the ball in their hands a lot on Saturday. Griedl had six carries and caught four passes against Peru State, while Walker rushed five times for 26 yards and caught three passes.

The Bulldogs returned all five starters on their offensive line that averages 280 pounds per man.

On defense, **Jerrod Fleming** and **Preston Harris** were both All-GPAC Second-Team selections last year. Fleming is a starting linebacker that led the Bulldogs with 12 total tackles last week. He also recorded a sack for a loss of nine yards. Harris is a starting cornerback who had five total stops last week and is one of the leaders in the secondary.

Kicker **Kenny Zoeller** was named the Victory Sports Network Special Teams player of the week. He converted a 27 yard and 42 yard field goal in the win over the Bobcats. Quarterback TJ Shirey also serves as the starting punter for Concordia.

Seward, Neb. — Kory Kahlandt had three rushing touchdowns and Jerod Franck scored on a 77-yard screen pass as the Nebraska Wesleyan offense racked up 422 yards of total offense in a 27-13 victory over Concordia University at Bulldog Stadium in Seward, Neb.

The Prairie Wolves jumped out to the 27-0 lead and Concordia added two late scores. NWU improved to 4-3 overall while the Bulldogs fell to 2-6.

After losing the last two games in Seward, the Prairie Wolves wasted little time in avoiding the upset this season. On the second possession of the game, Kahlandt broke free and ran 68 yards for the opening TD. The second of Kahlandt's three TDs came in the second quarter on a 16-yard run. The play was set up by a 47-yard pass from Matt Hagge to Frank.

NWU led 14-0 at halftime, and scored on their first possession of the second half. Mike Millard gave the Prairie Wolves great field position with a 54-yard punt return down to the 21-yard line. Kahlandt scored his final TD on a 17-yard run.

The final touchdown was on the very next possession as Frank scampered 77 yards after catching a screen pass. NWU scored two touchdowns in the first four plays of the second half. The Prairie Wolves had gone six quarters without a TD, but the NWU offense was very impressive in the victory.

Kahlandt finished the game with 180 yards on 22 carries. He tied the NWU single season record for rushing TDs with 14 now on the year. Franck caught two passes for 124 yards and had one rush for 15 yards in his return to his hometown of Seward. Hagge finished 8-21 for 212 yards and a touchdown, with one interception.

The Prairie Wolves defense had another solid performance as they limited Concordia to only five first downs in the first half. Defensive end Cameron Kolling was all over the field and in the Bulldog backfield finishing with 4.0 tackles-for-loss and 2.0 quarterback sacks with 12 total tackles. He also blocked the Bulldogs PAT attempt. Garrett Rippen added 11 total tackles and Luke Luethchens had his third interception of the season.

Concordia had 85 rushing yards as a team and the two quarterbacks combined to go 13-34 for 193 yards.
