UNIQUE COURSE FORMATS. Although all courses meet within a shortened timeframe, you should be aware that the number of contact hours and the expectations for outside preparation follow the same guidelines as courses offered during a regular semester. Courses may begin and end on a variety of dates. Read the individual course listings carefully to identify dates as well as prerequisites, costs and other requirements.

CREDIT HOUR LIMITATIONS. Because a Winter Term course is expected to fully occupy a student's academic schedule, registration is limited to three credit hours. Auditing is not available.

COST & PAYMENT. Tuition is \$262 per credit hour. Other fees and costs may also apply.

Tuition and applicable fees are due at the Business Office by **December 28, 2011**. Accounts not paid by this deadline will be assessed a \$40 late payment fee. Students should refer to WebAdvisor or contact the Business Office for account balances/tuition statements.

Some courses may require early payment for part or all of the tuition and fees. Scholarships and special discounts are not applicable for the Winter Term program. Deferred payments will not be allowed.

HOUSING. On-campus Winter Term housing is available on a limited basis for Nebraska Wesleyan students for a moderate fee. If you are interested in housing information, please contact the Residence Life Office by December 2.

REGISTRATION. Registration begins in conjunction with Spring pre-registration, November 10-23, and continues through December 28, although cancellation decisions will be made after December 2, based on enrollments at that time. Once you register it is your responsibility to contact the Registrar's Office if you need to cancel your registration.

Nebraska Wesleyan reserves the right to cancel any courses for insufficient enrollment. Classes enrolling fewer than six students may be canceled. Decisions to cancel courses will be made after December 2 and posted on the bulletin board outside the Registrar's Office.

WITHDRAWAL AND REFUND POLICY. Students who find it necessary, for any reason, to withdraw from Winter Term courses receive refunds for tuition on a prorated basis. Please see the Business Office for details.
