C. EDUCATION ABROAD GRANTS

1. ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES:

- a. NWU students studying on an exchange program or student teaching abroad are eligible to apply for a grant.
- b. Education Abroad Grants are available to full-time, degree-seeking NWU students who
 - have been enrolled for two consecutive semesters at NWU
 - have at least a 2.75 GPA (if your GPA is below 2.75, you must include a letter of recommendation from a faculty member who is familiar with your academic ability and can comment on your academic potential in an overseas setting).
 - have demonstrated financial need and
 - will enroll in an approved exchange program abroad which awards college credit.

2. APPLICATION PROCEDURES:

Submit a **complete application** to the Director of Global Engagement including signature & date.

*****Additionally, please complete your FAFSA as soon as possible, but no later than the application deadline for fall semester/yearlong programs.*****

3. APPLICATION DEADLINE. Your complete application should be submitted no later than the dates below. Late applications will not be considered.

- 23 October for spring semester programs**
- 18 March for fall semester/yearlong programs**

4. AWARDS:

Awards are made on the basis of financial need, airfare cost, duration of program, and language study. NWU reserves the right to adjust the award amount if you win another study abroad scholarship.

5. DISBURSEMENT OF GRANTS:

After you have turned in the required forms for study abroad to the Office of Global Engagement, (OGE) bring your letter of award to the OGE. The grants will be awarded to your NWU account during the term you study abroad.

6. PARTIAL OR TOTAL REIMBURSEMENT OF GRANTS:

If, after receiving a grant, you are unable to study abroad, you must reimburse the total amount of the grant. If you withdraw from the program before its completion, you must reimburse part of the grant you received; the amount will be determined by the International Education Committee.
