



Please Note: In order to receive an Education Abroad Grant for summer or winter programs, you must take the course for credit.

EDUCATION ABROAD GRANTS

1. ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES:

Education Abroad Grants are available to full-time, degree-seeking NWU students who

- have at least a 2.75 GPA (if your GPA is below 2.75, you must include a letter of recommendation from a faculty member who is familiar with your academic ability and can comment on your academic potential in an overseas setting).

- will enroll in a NWU program abroad for credit.

2. APPLICATION PROCEDURES:

Submit electronically a **complete application** including signature & date by using this procedure:
Name your file with the following format: **lastnamefirstname_EAG.pdf** and then email it to international@nebrweslevan.edu.

*****Additionally, please complete your FAFSA as soon as possible, but no later than the application deadline for fall semester/yearlong programs.*****

3. APPLICATION DEADLINE: (Late applications will not be considered.)

Feel free to submit earlier. Applications are reviewed on a monthly basis so the earlier you submit, the sooner you find out.

- **29 October for winter or spring break programs**
- **31 March for summer programs**

4. DISBURSEMENT OF GRANTS:

After you have registered for credit for the study abroad program, have attended the orientation, and have turned in all required forms, bring your award letter* to the Office of Global Engagement (OGE) to officially accept your grant. The grant will be awarded to your NWU account during the term you study abroad. *You will receive this letter via your NWU email.

5. PARTIAL OR TOTAL REIMBURSEMENT OF GRANTS:

A. If you register for credit other than that which you indicated on the application form, the amount of the grant can be altered up or down. Please tell the Director of Global Engagement if your credit changes. The decision will be made by the International Education Committee.

B. If, after receiving a grant, you are unable to study abroad, you must reimburse the total amount of the grant. If you withdraw from the program before its completion, you must reimburse part of the grant you received; the amount will be determined by the International Education Committee.
