HATTIE JOHNS AND HELEN JOHNS FULTON ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP

Craig and Elizabeth Wanamaker established the Hattie Johns and Helen Johns Fulton Endowed Scholarship to encourage NWU students to travel outside of the United States to study and experience cultures other than their own. The scholarship is named in honor of Craig Wanamaker's Aunt Hattie Johns and Grandmother Helen Johns Fulton. Hamilton County residents, Aunt Hattie and Grandma Fulton believed in the value of education and had a huge positive impact on Craig. The scholarship will provide financial assistance to students for costs associated with travel/study abroad. One \$400 scholarship for each semester and one \$150 scholarship for each short-term (less than 1 semester) period will be available.

NICK LEE STUDY ABROAD SCHOLARSHIP

Marti and Ron Lee established the Nick Lee Study Abroad Scholarship as a part of a commemoration of the joyful life of their son, Nick Lee. Because Nick was actively involved with various NWU international programs and participated in a NWU semester study abroad program, Marti and Ron wanted to keep Nick's spirit alive. The scholarship will provide financial assistance to NWU students for costs associated with study abroad. One \$400 scholarship for each semester will be available.

1. ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES:

Full-time, degree-seeking NWU students who

- have been enrolled for two consecutive semesters at NWU
- have at least a 2.5 GPA.
- will enroll in an approved study abroad program that awards college credit OR will travel abroad on an approved program.

2. APPLICATION PROCEDURES:

Use Email (international@nebrwesleyan.edu) to submit a complete application ELECTRONICALLY to the Director of Global Engagement including essay, signature and date.

- 3. APPLICATION DEADLINE. Your complete application should be submitted <u>no later</u> than the dates below. Late applications will not be considered.
 - 26 September for spring semester or winter programs
 - 25 January for fall semester/yearlong or summer programs

4. REQUIREMENTS:

The semester you return to NWU, you are required to do the following:

- 1) Provide at least one presentation about your study/travel abroad experience and/or cultural information on campus and invite the Wanamaker family to attend your presentation.
- 2) Send a thank-you note to the Wanamaker family with photos taken during your experience.

6. DISBURSEMENT OF SCHOLARSHIP:

After you have turned in the required forms for study/travelabroad to the Office of Global Engagement (OGE), bring your letter of award to the OGE. The scholarship will be awarded to your NWU account during the term that you go abroad.

7. PARTIAL OR TOTAL REIMBURSEMENT OF SCHOLARSHIP:

If, after receiving a scholarship, you are unable to study/travel abroad, you must reimburse the total amount of the scholarship. If you withdraw from the program before its completion, you must reimburse part of the scholarship you received; the amount will be determined by the International Education Committee.

After you have turned in the required forms for study/travel abroad to the Office of Global Engagement (OGE), bring your award letter to the OGE (you will receive this letter in an email sent to your NWU email). If you do not turn in the award letter to the OGE by the deadline listed on the letter, you will not receive a scholarship.
