Sells Scholarship Award

A scholarship in honor of Floyd and Charlotte Sells, established by their grandson, Dr. Rich Patrick, former Chair of the Business/Accounting/Economics Department, is presented annually to a student in the human resource management, management or marketing area.

The scholarship is in the amount of \$2,512.00 for the academic year. A scholarship recipient is selected each spring semester for the following year.

Eligibility

To be eligible for selection to receive this scholarship, students must meet the following criteria:

- 1) The student must be enrolled full-time at NWU and be a declared business administration, international business or business sociology major. No accounting or economics majors or minors may be considered for this scholarship.
- 2) The student must have attained at least sophomore standing with a minimum of one full-time semester remaining before graduation.
- 3) The student must have a major or minor with emphasis in marketing, management or human resource management
- 4) The student must have an overall GPA of at least 3.0 in all courses completed and a GPA of 3.0 or above in all economics and business courses completed.

Financial need, academic commitment, hard work and campus activities, especially those related to the Business/Accounting/Economics department, may also be considered in selecting the recipient of this scholarship.

Application Procedure and Deadline

All students who are interested in and eligible for the scholarship must obtain an application form from the Business Administration/Economics Department office and submit the completed form and requested information to the Chair of the Department by May 1, 2020. The application may be transposed to a computer for convenience.
