- The University Registrar at Nebraska Wesleyan will conduct a course-by-course evaluation of official transcripts to apply courses to general education, academic major, and degree requirements.
- Required coursework can vary depending on a student's degree program, transferring credit, and other factors. Requirements and transfer equivalencies can change. Ask your admissions counselor for more information
- Courses must have a grade of C- or higher to be considered for transfer.
- A maximum of 96 quarter hours/64 semester hours can be transferred from CCC. Students must complete a total of 126 semester hours to earn a bachelor's degree from NWU.
