Application Requirements

Applications are reviewed based on the following criteria/materials:

- Cumulative High School GPA of a 3.0 on a 4.0 scale, from an accredited high school or GED.
- Cumulative GPA of a 3.0 on a 4.0 scale for high school STEM curriculum (Math and Science).
- An ACT composite score of 21 and above or SAT total of 1500 and above.
- Cumulative College GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- Two references (letters).
- Interview for qualified applicants on an invitation basis.

Application Instructions

To be considered for admission, the following items must be submitted to Dr. Bricker (OLIN 213, x2446, jbricker@nebrwesleyan.edu) by the **February 9, 2018 deadline**:

- Completed application form.
- High School Transcript and grading scale (unofficial copies are accepted).
- ACT or SAT scores.
- (Un)official College/University Transcript(s) from each institution attended.
- Two references, on enclosed forms, completed by individuals who are not relatives (i.e., teachers, employers, counselors, mentors, advisors). NWU faculty associated with the INBRE Program are not eligible to serve as references.
- Qualified applicants may be offered an interview provided the above required items are received.
