Full-time performance music students may enroll for up to four credit hours of applied music lessons per semester without charge.</i>	
Music minors: <i>Full-time music minors may enroll for up to three credit hours of applied music lessons per semester without charge, for a maximum of four semesters. Lessons taken as a part-time student, or lessons taken beyond the four semesters, are charged the standard applied music fee.</i>	
Non-music majors or minors: <i>Students (full- or part-time) are charged for applied lessons and are limited to one credit hour of lesson each semester.</i>
