Rwanda: Genocide and Beyond May 30 to June 26, 2022**

See a new image of modern Africa by spending a month in Rwanda. Though students in the US mainly know Rwanda for the 1994 genocide against the Tutsi, this program gives you the chance to witness post-conflict reconstruction and renewal firsthand. During the first half of our stay, the group visits genocide memorials, reconciliation communities, women's cooperatives, and organizations promoting the co-existence of survivors and perpetrators. While much of our time is spent in the capital, Kigali, we also take brief trips to rural areas to visit local villages, artisans, and explore the natural beauty of the nation. During the second half of our stay, we will serve the community through internships related to our majors or areas of academic interest. Amy Spears, Associate Professor of Music, and Lisa Wilkinson, Professor of Philosophy and Gender Studies, co-lead the program. Estimated cost: \$4700 per student + meals (if 10 students take the course). Additional fees apply for an optional 6 NWU Credits. **Application and nonrefundable deposit of \$1000 are due Mar. 1, 2022. Payment of \$1000 due March 31, 2022. Salamanca, Spain May 31-July 2, 2022**

Spend June 2022 in Salamanca, Spain and earn 4 credits in 4 weeks studying Spanish language and culture at the Colegio Delibes. Credits include EL-Intensive and may count toward Modern Language Literacy, the Modern Language minor, or the major. Estimated cost: \$4,250 plus round-trip airfare. Cost includes 5 days & 4 nights in Madrid with most meals and excursion to Segovia, homestay in Salamanca with a host family (private room with laundry), meals with family, group activities and excursions in and around Salamanca, and tuition. Applications and an **\$800 non-refundable* deposit are due on January 18, 2022**. COMM 2360: Experiencing the Culture of Italy Approximately May 15 to June 2, 2022

Encounter the culture of Tuscany in Italy! Students in this study abroad class travel to Florence, Italy and surrounding areas to study cultural indicators such as verbal and nonverbal communication, food, transportation, business climate, politics, religious beliefs, and interpersonal relationships. Students read texts, listen/give presentations, view art, attend concerts, experience the culture of Florence through walking, watching, eating, shopping and navigating the city and reflect on these experiences. Students stay in apartments. Students can earn credit for the global diversity requirement in the Archway Curriculum. Estimated cost: \$5,000 (plus the cost of 3 NWU Credits). Pre-departure class sessions and a study abroad orientation are required. **Applications and a \$500 non-refundable deposit are due on December 6, 2021. HHP 4900: History, Culture & Sport in Ireland May 10 to May 23, 2022

Students will visit Ireland and be introduced to an excellent mixture of history, culture, and sport. Activities will include historical walking tours, visits to universities, museums, businesses, sporting facilities, experiencing local foods, music and dance, and partaking in activities specific to Ireland. Students will join lectures at universities and meet local students. We will spend time in Dublin, Galway, County Clare, and County Kerry. This course is open to students from all majors (NWU or other universities) and is open for first year through recent graduates. The estimated cost is \$5,240, and it includes round-trip airfare, all academic visits, and lectures, accommodations, program activities, event fees, local transportation, and selected meals. Students can earn 3 NWU credits for an additional \$1,125. **A deposit of \$100 is due Dec 1, 2021; second payment of \$600 due by February 1, 2022; and the remaining balance is due by March 28, 2022. Refund Policy: December 1-February 1: \$100 is non-refundable; February 2 – March 28, \$300 of \$600 second deposit is non-refundable; after March 29: zero refundable (tickets will be purchased).** **Contact:** Dr. Pat Pettit at pdp@nebrwesleyan.edu.

Ukraine: Economics of Transition May 9 to May 30, 2022

Study the transition economies of the Post-Soviet countries and Eastern Europe with the focus on Ukraine during this three-week course. The first week will be at NWU and the rest of the course will be spent in Ukraine. Students will learn about transition economies before traveling to Ukraine to explore what its economy in transition looks like, meeting with and interviewing representatives of business, government, and academia in Ukraine. **Estimated cost is \$3500 per student including airfare, lodging, transportation, and most meals (tuition not included).** **Application & non-refundable* deposit of \$1000 is due February 1, 2022** to Dr. Khanzhyn, SC 240C. **Contact:** Dr. Khanzhyn at vkhanzhy@nebrwesleyan.edu
