Earn College Credit with Nebraska Wesleyan Honors Academy

Registration steps

1. Go to honorsacademy.nebrwesleyan.edu and click on "Register Online".
2. Fill in your contact information and select your high school. Please use your home email address rather than a school email. It is also vital to enter your correct social security number. On the next page, select the classes you wish to receive credit for. Check with your teacher if you aren't sure which class to select.
3. Select your payment method. Payment is not due at the time of registration and you can select a different payment option when you pay. We send paper statements around the 20th of each month. Please remit your payment or set up a payment plan when you receive that statement. To apply for ACE funding, see your high school counselor and complete the application form.
4. On the next page, read the "conditions of credit" and check the box, "I accept the conditions of credit stated above." Click "Submit." You will receive a confirmation email for your records. Please save this for future reference.

Once you have properly submitted the form, a web page confirmation will appear with a link to order your Honors Academy T-shirt. This link will also be included in your confirmation email. Only one T-shirt order will be accepted per student, regardless of the number of classes you enroll in during the year.

The registration deadline is October 6, 2017, for most fall and full year courses and February 16, 2018, for spring courses. This gives you time to confirm that credit will transfer to colleges on your list.

Three payment choices

1. Make a one-time payment directly to NWU.
Once you receive your bill, pay with a check, credit card or money order.
2. Set up an interest-free monthly payment plan.
Once you receive your bill, you can set up a monthly payment plan through Nelnet Business Solutions. There is a service fee to use this option.
3. Apply for an ACE Scholarship.
Students who demonstrate financial need may apply for and receive an Accessing College Early (ACE) scholarship. Information about this program is available at ccpe.nebraska.gov/ACE. Please contact your high school guidance counselor to apply.
NOTE: In 2017-2018, ACE will only cover the cost of two dual-credit courses per student.

Drops and withdrawals

Because you are concurrently enrolled at your high school and at Nebraska Wesleyan, you must contact both institutions if you choose to drop a course.

Drop deadlines for all courses are the same as the registration deadlines, October 6, 2017, and February 16, 2018, and can be found on your online registration confirmation and at honorsacademy.nebrwesleyan.edu. Dropped courses do not appear on your transcript and tuition is refunded. After the drop deadlines, you may still withdraw from courses, but a "W" will appear on your transcript and you are still obligated for the tuition payment. To drop or withdraw from a course, complete the drop/add/withdraw petition at honorsacademy.nebrwesleyan.edu.
