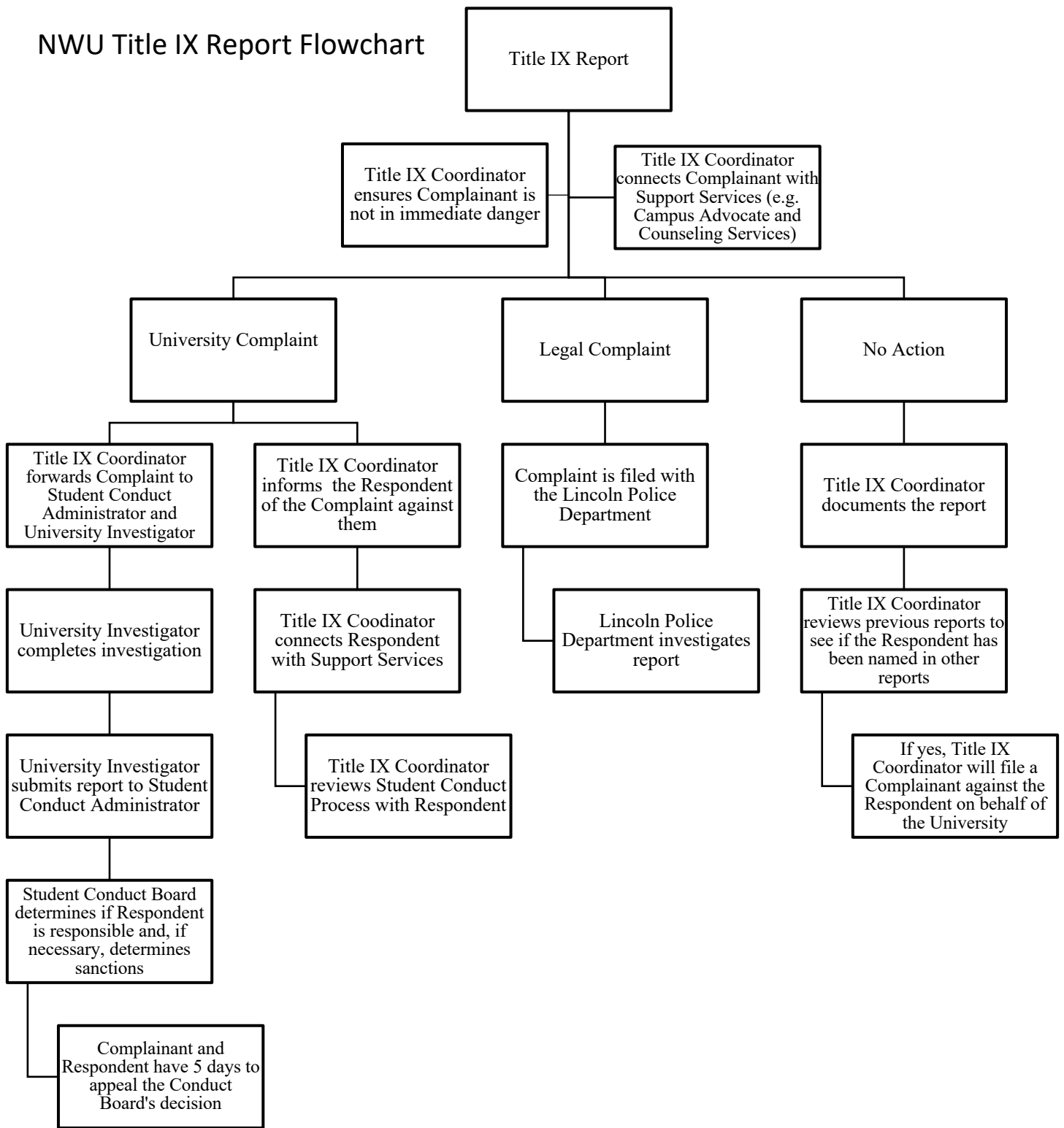


# NWU Title IX Report Flowchart

# Title IX Reporting

A student or responsible employee (instructor, staff member) may make a report of an incident of sexual assault, stalking, intimate partner violence, or sexual harassment directly to the Title IX Coordinator.

*The person making a report/ complaint or for whom the report/ complaint is made is known as a complainant.  
The person about whom the report/ complaint is made is known as the respondent.*

## Upon receiving a report, the Title IX Coordinator will:

- Contact the complainant if they did not make the report
- Assess their safety
- Connect them with support services

## Title IX Report

If the student requests **NO** investigation of the incident, the Title IX Coordinator will document the report.

The student may decide to file a Title IX Complaint at any time.

The Title IX Coordinator will review previous reports to see:

- If the respondent has been named in other reports
- If the situation described in the report poses a risk to the campus

If the situation described in the report poses a risk to campus, the Title IX Coordinator will file a Title IX Complaint.

## Title IX Complaint

A Title IX Complaint will be filed if the complainant requests the university investigate the report, or if the situation reported to the Title IX Coordinator poses a risk to the campus community.

The Title IX Coordinator will promptly notify the respondent of the complaint. The respondent will be connected with support services. The Title IX Coordinator will review the process with the respondent.

The Title IX Coordinator will forward the complaint to the Student Conduct Administrator and Title IX Investigator.

The Title IX Investigator will interview the complainant, respondent, and any witnesses brought forward. The Title IX Investigator will write a report summarizing the information.

The Title IX Investigator will submit the report to the Student Conduct Administrator.

The Student Conduct Administrator will convene the Student Conduct Board.

The Student Conduct Board will review the report and determine if the Respondent is responsible.

If the Respondent is found responsible, the Student Conduct Board will determine sanctions.

## Legal Complaint

If the complainant decides to make a police report, the university still has an obligation to address the Title IX Complaint.

A criminal investigation and university investigation may occur simultaneously.
